





HOW TARPS ARE MADE




Just about all tarps, regardless of their finished sizes, start off on a roll from mills in the US or manufacturers overseas.

Typically tarp rolls are between 60"-72" wide and about 100 yards long, although you will certainly find tarp rolls of other varying widths and lengths.

Once tarp rolls are brought to the plant, fabric panels are measured and cut from the rolls. If the width of the finished tarp is wider than the width of the roll fabric, tarp panels need to be joined together to meet the desired dimensions.





Once you have reached the desired dimensions in length and width from joining together the fabric panels, the edges of the tarps are folded over and hemmed in for reinforcement. This is where you will lose a few inches in the Finished Size of tarp from the fabric previously taken off the roll.

After the edges are hemmed and the grommets are inserted, the tarp is ready for use. It is folded and packed to be shipped!



HOW TO CUSTOM BUILD A TARP



Desired Use of Custom Tarps

How the tarp is intended to be used is the very first question that needs to be addressed. Is the tarp being used as a wall? Is it being used as a roof? Will it be hung similar to a safety net? Will it be used to cover machinery or equipment?

Location

Outdoors: it is recommended that you use a vinyl material or our most durable poly materials such as the 7oz 12 Mil Super Heavy Duty Poly Tarps.

Indoors: We recommended using the allnatural canvas tarps. Another good option is our Duramost™ Polyester






Aesthetics Requirements

If the tarps need to be a specific color, the most likely option would be vinyl.

Meanwhile, Flame-Retardant vinyl has as many as 9 color options including black, blue, gray, green, red, tan, white, yellow, and translucent.

Rain and Wind Protection


In case of heavy rain or wind, use a poly tarp as a shield. Secure it properly to ensure it stays in place during the storm.

Poly Tarps (Polyethylene)

Poly tarps are considered to be all-purpose tarps. The materials themselves are 100% waterproof and shrink-proof, which can be used for construction, landscaping, agriculture, lawn & and garden, home improvement, hardware, recreation, roofing or even camping.

Canvas Tarps

Canvas tarps are made of either duck cotton or polyester. It is considered one of the toughest and most durable materials in the tarp market. Canvas is typically used for outdoors, construction, machine & and tractor covers, building materials, and much more.





Vinyl Tarps

Vinyl tarps are considered to be one of the strongest compared to other tarp materials. Vinyl Tarp is 100% waterproof and can hold water very well. Long-lasting compared to other types of materials as it serves to protect against harsh elements and rough water.

Mesh Tarps

Think of mesh tarps as screen materials. It could be considered as shade to block the sunlight. The percentage of mesh tarp indicates how much it could block the UV rays. Mesh tarp percentages include 55%, 70%, 86%, 87%, and 95%.





TOP FACTORS

WHEN BUYING CANVAS TARPS



Grommet Spacing

Grommet spacing determines the distance between each grommet along the tarp's edge. Closer spacing ensures better tiedown options and increased tear resistance, enhancing overall security.



Select canvas material and thickness based on your specific tarp needs and usage. For heavy use, opt for thicker and more durable canvas for better resilience.





Reinforcements

Grommets are reinforced with extra webbing inside the hem for added strength in high-stress areas. If extensive stress is expected on the corners and grommets while using a tarp, reinforcement is essential for durability.

Treated vs. Untreated

Treated canvas tarps repel water, safeguarding items from moisture. Untreated tarps lack water resistance, allowing water seepage. For outdoor or moisture-exposed use, choose treated canvas tarps for reliable protection.
